PACKING LIST AND CAMPER EXPECTATIONS

Essential items you should bring (please label all of your belongings with your name and phone number!)

- Your instrument and bow (in the case)
- Folding music stand
- Accessories (rosin, spare strings, end pin stop, shoulder rest)
- Your music and A PENCIL FOR REHEARSALS
- Water bottle (very important!)
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Sleeping bag or sheets, blanket, pillow(s), pillow case(s)
- Bath towel, toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc)
- Flashlight or headlamp
- Four days of clean, comfortable clothes for moving around in, including underwear and socks
- Swimsuit and swim towel
- Comfortable shoes for walking and hiking in, at least one pair of closed-toed shoes (for safety and warmth)
- Warm outerwear (long sleeves/pants, jacket/coat, hat/scarf/gloves)
- Warm clothes and socks to sleep in (it can get chilly at night)
- Umbrella and/or rain poncho in case it rains
- IF YOU ARE HORSEBACK RIDING: you must wear long pants (to your ankles), closed-toed shoes, socks, and long sleeves. Each rider will be given a helmet to wear.
- **A mask or other facial covering is optional.**

What you could bring (optional suggestions)

- Wristwatch
- Alarm clock
- Sunglasses
- Camera to take pictures
- Folding camping chair
- White, neon, or black clothes for dodgeball
- Snacks, candy, and drinks that do not need to be chilled (NO nuts)
- A bit of spending money for the gift shop

What you should NOT bring

- Cell phone, computer, tablet, video games, or any other electronics (these will be confiscated)
- Weapons, drugs, tobacco, and alcohol are not allowed. Offenders will be reported to the police and sent home immediately.

Expectations for Campers

- Lights out at bed checks. Counselors will take visual account for every camper.
- Campers are only permitted in their assigned cabin or room. No exceptions.
- Campers are not permitted to be in, on, or otherwise sharing any bed with another person. Respecting the personal space of others is required, for the safety and comfortability of all campers and staff. Campers sharing beds at any time will not be tolerated.
- Campers are not to leave their room/cabin after lights out, unless there is an emergency or to use the restroom.
- No campers are permitted in the lodging area without a counselor in the vicinity.
- Campers of any age are not permitted to drive themselves to camp and check-in without a legal guardian present. No exceptions.
- Any damages to Golden Bell property will be charged to the responsible camper(s).
- Campers will treat all camp staff, Golden Bell staff, and each other with respect at all times.
- Cell phones are not allowed at camp. You must leave it in the possession of your parents.
- Campers are expected to participate in all activities.
- Problems of any kind should be reported first to your counselor, and then to the Camp Director.
